REGISTRATION DATES

Applications will be accepted January 20, 2010 for returning preschool families. Registration for Prince of Peace parishioners is January 27, 2010. Applications will be accepted January 29, 2010 for the community.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Our preschool day runs from 9:00 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. Children eat lunch at school. Extra curricular activities are available.

TUITION AND REGISTRATION FEES

Registration fees are due at the time of enrollment. These fees are non-refundable and are equivalent of one month's tuition. You may choose the following payment options. First tuition payment is due July 10, 2010.
